These include the classic 'A' warning sign (waste warning sign), which is available in three versions. As a magnetic version for flexible use, for permanent mounting for long-term use and as a foldable version with a practical mounting kit. The magnetic version should be removed when it is no longer needed or during vehicle cleaning.</p> <p>DT Spare Parts offers orange warning signs for the transport of hazardous goods, which are displayed as soon as hazardous goods are loaded. In this case, the specific regulations are to be strictly followed. The range is supplemented by self-adhesive warning labels in the colours red, yellow and white as well as special adhesive signs for the back of the trailer.</p> <p>The E-certified warning labels are supplied with installation instructions that indicate exactly where the labels must be attached. This ensures a fast and standard-compliant installation. The warning flags for loading platforms are self-reflecting and must be replaced immediately if they are damaged or become less effective in order to ensure road safety. In addition, clear labelling of the left or right-hand side makes it easier to install them quickly and correctly.</p> <p>When securing the warning signs, make sure that suitable screws are used. "SPAX screws should not be used", informs Kevin.
